Session 2

Developing a Vision for the Hamilton Township School District

On October 24, 2023, Hamilton Township School District administrators, Board of Education members, staff, parents, and community members, twenty-four (24) total, came together for the second strategic planning meeting. The topic for the second meeting focused on developing a vision and initiatives for the Hamilton Township School District. The meeting began with a welcome and introduction by Superintendent Dr. Jeffrey Zito. Facilitator Michelle Kennedy, from the New Jersey School Boards Association (NJSBA), was introduced and provided an overview of the strategic planning process and the focus of the evening's activity.

We reviewed the consensus process utilized in strategic planning. Participants watched a video that allowed them to think about the future we are preparing our students for, and the skills needed for future success. We then envisioned the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) selecting the Hamilton Township School District as the model district for success in advancing student achievement. The task is to produce a Podcast sharing Hamilton Township's success, which will broadcast throughout NJ and globally as part of the NJDOE roadmap to success in education. The Podcast is to talk about what is taking place in the Hamilton Township School District that made it possible for the district to become the model district for success in advancing student achievement - What does the Hamilton Township School District's desired future look like in 3-5 years from now, where everyone is succeeding, and there are no barriers?

Participants were encouraged to think about the big picture with money not being a concern and no restrictions.

Participants gathered in self-assigned groups, four (4) in total, to produce their Podcast, which included the name of the Podcast and highlights of what was taking place to achieve success at Hamilton Township School District. The small groups reviewed the outcomes from meeting #1, strengths and challenges, and then began brainstorming on their vision for the district. After group discussions, each group identified their consensus points and presented those to the entire group of meeting participants.

The following information is a summary of the work of the small groups. As discussed with the meeting participants, all consensus points are recorded and posted on the district website to share the group work during the strategic planning process.
