Dear Parent/Guardian:

The eighth grade will be going on a class trip to “The Cove” at Lake Lenape in Mays Landing on Friday, June 6th. The rain date will be June 9th. Students will leave Davies School at 9:15 a.m. and will be transported back to school from the park at approximately 1:45 p.m. Transportation and activities are provided by the Davies School, with the funds donated by the Hamilton Township PTA. Free lunch will be available to each student (2 hamburgers, 2 hot dogs or 1 of each, drinks, chips, pasta salad and watermelon). No food, water bottles or outside beverages are permitted. We will also have a snow cone machine and cotton candy machine free of charge to the students.

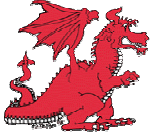
All activities will be supervised by our staff. These will include beach and water volleyball, relay races, a teacher dunk tank, pie eating contest, limbo contest and other beach/water related activities. In addition, there will be a craft area in the shaded section of the park. Swimming will be permitted under the protection of lifeguards and our staff. **Students are expected to wear conservative and appropriate swimwear or they will be removed from the day’s activities until acceptable dress standards are met.** T-shirts will be distributed to all students free of charge. These are to be worn at the park. Furthermore, it is the responsibility of the student to bring and apply their own sun block protection as needed. Throughout the day, Davies DJ’s will be announcing various student performances and contests. Davies teachers will be involved in the planning and supervision of all activities.

Yearbooks, Ipods, cell phones, radios, digital cameras, and other valuable items are not permitted, as the school will not be responsible for these items. Disposable cameras are allowed, however. The normal dress code applies, as do all school rules. Students must ride their assigned buses to and from the park and follow the direction of staff chaperones in all matters. Permission slips are attached. We anticipate a fun filled day for our students who have behaved appropriately throughout this school year. As always, I thank you for your continued support.
